Shredder Receptacle v. Recycling Bins....

There are recycling bins located on each floor of the building in the laundry rooms, and a shredder receptacle is located in the Administrative Offices in the Copy Room. 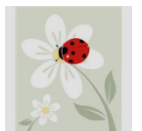
